

1. PALMA, MALLORCA

The biggest of the Balearics often gets short shrift in comparison to the eternal appeal of Ibiza and the low-key charm of Menorca and Formentera. But Mallorca's capital, Palma, in particular has the perfect fusion of urban cool and laid-back Mediterranean-island living. Plus, it's always been stuffed silly with wonderfully characterful small hotels. And the new arrivals keep coming.



Set just inside the renovated sea walls, Es Princep opened in February with 68 sleek bedrooms along with a rooftop pool for surveying the bay between sunbathing. Food here is overseen by local chef Andreu Genestra, of his eponymous Michelin-starred restaurant in Capdepera, who makes the most of the just-caught fish landing on his doorstep.
