A Guide to Mallorca's Hottest Hotel Openings of 2017/18

Mallorca tourism has been seriously booming of late, and the Balearic isle has been upping its game with the opening of some particularly impressive hotels, most catering to travellers who are willing to splash out for a high-end stay. Here's our round-up of the hottest new hotels that have opened on the island in the last year.

Bucking the trend for restored period properties, the Es Príncep is a purpose-built five-star hotel opened in 2018. It is set overlooking the southeastern corner of Palma's old city walls, and is named after the prince who oversaw their construction. Interiors are a flawless mix of muted contemporary styling and understated minimalism, and there is a raft of facilities befitting of its upmarket atmosphere. Most of the 68 rooms offer some kind of view of the nearby sea, though the best panoramas can be enjoyed from the hotel's rooftop terrace and pool. A spa, excellent dining options and a swish cocktail bar complete a genuinely high-end package.
