Seven fabulous new Majorca hotels for 2018

The Balearic island of Majorca makes for a good break in spring, summer or autumn, for either a city break in Palma, a fly-and flop trip to the coast or rural retreat. Lucky then, that this year has seen some diverse openings across the island, from a boho-chic resort in Port Soller to a medieval mansion in Palma - and you can expect rooftop pools and Michelin-starred chefs, too



Hotel Es Princep, Palma de Mallorca

February saw the opening of five-star Hotel Es Princep, located in the Calatrava area of Palma right beside the restored ancient walls. Guests can enjoy two pools: one in the basement spa, complemented by a hot tub, sauna and salt room; and one up on the rooftop terrace with far-reaching views including the Bay of Palma and the cathedral. Local Michelin-starred chef Andreu Genestra is in charge of the restaurants, all-day Mura and fine-dining spot Balaroja, where menus feature most island-grown ingredients.
