CITY BREAKS: THE 27 HOTTEST HOTELS IN EUROPE THAT YOU SHOULD BE STAYING IN THIS SUMMER

It's not all about the beach; summer city breaks can provide the same rejuvenation you feel after a coastal or country break - especially if you pick the right hotel. We've rounded up the hottest new places to stay in European cities - from London to Lisbon, Barcelona to Berlin. They have been selected because they might have rooftop pools with views of the city's monuments; hidden courtyards where you can sip summery cocktails; or they could be situated next door to - or indeed within a park. Some have the city's hottest new restaurants and bars under (or on top of) their roofs. And others might be sanctuaries to which you can escape from the heat of the day.

Hotel Es Princep, Palma de Mallorca

Five-star Hotel Es Princep is situated in a quiet corner of the old town, close to the ancient ramparts and with magnificent panoramic views of Palma Bay. Subterranean Coco Oasis Spa has an 18-metre pool with whirlpool tub, a dry salt cabin, Turkish bath and Sauna, as well as a fully equipped gym and treatment rooms. For water babies, there's yet another ample infinity pool on the rooftop terrace along with copious loungers and the Almaq Bar. The two restaurants are overseen by the famed local chef Andreu Genestra. Seascapes can be enjoyed from all rooms, though some have partial views of the old town. Several have small balconies while corner rooms 115, 312 and 412 scoop the best vistas.
